



## **Flea Preparation Checklist**

*Please complete all steps **before your scheduled service**. Incomplete preparation may delay treatment or reduce effectiveness. For questions, **call 309-263-0341***

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### **Pets**

- ☐ Treat all pets with a veterinarian-approved flea product prior to service.
  - ☐ Remove all pets from the home during treatment.
  - ☐ Remove or securely cover aquariums and turn off air pumps.
  - ☐ Wash all pet bedding in **hot water** and dry on **high heat**.
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### **Inside the Home**

- ☐ Vacuum all carpets, rugs, furniture, and floors thoroughly (especially where pets rest).
  - ☐ Dispose of vacuum bags/canister contents in sealed trash bags **outside**.
  - ☐ Mop hard-surface floors.
  - ☐ Remove items from floors (toys, shoes, storage bins, pet food dishes).
  - ☐ Wash bedding, throw rugs, and small fabric items in hot water/high heat.
  - ☐ Declutter rooms for maximum treatment coverage.
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### **Day of Treatment**

- ☐ Everyone (including pets) must vacate the home for **4–6 hours (or as instructed)**.
  - ☐ Cover or store any exposed food, dishes, and utensils.
  - ☐ Do not clean floors, carpets, or upholstered furniture for at least **2 weeks** after treatment (**vacuuming is allowed after 24 hours**).
  - ☐ Expect to see some fleas for up to **2–3 weeks** as eggs continue to hatch.
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***Reminder:*** Treating pets, vacuuming, and following post treatment steps are critical for success
